Abstract

The paradigms of "Open Science" and "Open Access" are key concepts in the agenda of the European Research Area and, therefore, they represent a commitment (and, in many ways, a challenge) both for individual researchers and for the institutions that are called to implement them. In this seminar (i) we will discuss how the University of Cagliari is moving in the broad area of "Open Science/Access" and (ii) we will deal with its underlying concepts and ongoing practices through the presentation of actual show-cases.
