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INTRODUCTION

The employability course has been designed in the framework of Task 4.4 and developed with the aim to:

- Allow students to develop relevant competences to pursue their professional career and to raise their employability and capacity for an entrepreneurial way of thinking.
- Specifically, to develop career development skills and self-knowledge and self-management skills useful to participate in EDUC Internship scheme.

The course has been developed on Moodle, and it will be made available to students during the year 2025. With a view to constantly improve and update the courses offered to EDUC Alliance students, the Employability Course will be evaluated by students. Depending on the feedback obtained from the participants, some changes may be introduced in view of possible future editions.

The course is divided in 3 modules with an estimated 6 hours of duration per module. There have been 7 itineraries designed: one for each country where internships would take place: Germany, Italy, Czech Republic, Hungary, France, Spain and Norway. Each itinerary consists of 3 modules, Module 1 and 3 are specific to the destination country and Module 2 is common for all itineraries. Upon registration, each student will choose a destination, and only that itinerary (Module 1 destination + Module 2 general + Module 3 destination) will be visible in order to complete it and obtain a certificate.

To validate the Employability course, the student must pass a final quiz for each one of the three modules with a minimum score of 50%. The quiz is composed of 10 questions with four alternatives, with only one correct option.

As the course has been developed on Moodle, which is not a public webpage, it is not possible to simply share a link to the course. For this reason, in this deliverable we provide a copy of the course structure and materials, as well as screenshots of the course, as they would not be publicly accessible outside the Moodle platform. For every resource in the course, we provide a link to view the resource (pdfs and other documents have been added to Teams to enable viewing. Each team has uploaded their videos to the Panopto server, with instructions to enable viewing. It has been each team's responsibility to make their own videos accessible to enable viewing.

Learning outcomes:


