Abstract	This document illustrates the methodology adopted by the Alliance in mapping key stakeholders at regional, national and European level on the basis of their potential interest in the main project outputs.

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1. Introduction

The aims of this deliverable are to: i) report on the methodology adopted by the Alliance to map stakeholders, at Regional, National, and European level, potentially interested in the main EDUC outputs; ii) list, for each main output, all the stakeholders identified.

First, it is useful to illustrate the context in which this mapping takes place. It is elaborated within WP6 “EDUC Impact, Dissemination and Sharing” which is articulated in three Tasks:

Task 6.1, which intends to expand the global dissemination activity of EDUC activities and results and strengthen the community building activity;

Task 6.2, whose objective is to contribute to inter-alliance collaboration and sharing of outputs of the EDUC Alliance;

Task 6.3 aims at creating a Network of EDUC Friends (stakeholders, alumni, donors and sponsors) and animating it.

Task 6.2 will focus attention on the outputs deemed most useful for some stakeholders. The latter will be able to exploit the EDUC outputs both directly and indirectly, by acting as a crucial vehicle to maximize the impact of achieved results and to promote their long-term sustainability.

Stakeholders’ mapping requires in-depth knowledge of the outputs that will be generated in the various Tasks. Since the working groups involved in the implementation of the activities of the 27 EDUC Tasks are composed of different profiles, depending on the topic and the expertise, the working group of Task 6.2 will act as “*trait d’union*” among them, through dialogue with members of the various Task groups: primarily with the Leads and Co-Leads, but also with the other members. Next step will be the organization of cross meetings among Tasks with synergic outputs and a holistic approach will be adopted to identify the main EDUC key strength areas.

2. Methodology to implement the Stakeholders’ Mapping exercise

2.1. Identifying the main EDUC outputs

Starting point was the analysis, Task by Task, of each output foreseen (for a total of 61 outputs, including deliverables and milestones.), in order to evaluate the relevance they could have for external stakeholders, together with the submission deadline and the public or sensitive level of dissemination. Taking into consideration that many outputs are scheduled in the years to come, it has been decided to perform a first evaluation, to be updated every year. This will allow to better understand the actual final contents of outputs, as some of them may change according to implementation paths, as well as to establish links between different outputs which could be offered to stakeholders through more interest capturing formats.

This means that the first mapping exercise is not exhaustive and additional outputs/stakeholders may be added in the future, so as some already mapped output can be eliminated as its content is not deemed anymore to be shared with Stakeholders.

2.2. Mapping Stakeholders potentially interested in EDUC outputs

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The stakeholders were identified by each partner at the Regional, National, and European level, and also included Associated partners. This exercise was made through internal consultation by each Partner with the experts involved in each task.

Stakeholders such as NGOs, associations, private companies, research centers, public institutions and organizations and have been identified on the basis of their potential interest in EDUC outputs (and on the potential interest of their own stakeholders).

4. Conclusion

The mapping exercise conducted as part of WP6 "Impact, Dissemination, and Sharing" plays a crucial role in defining which outputs, generated within the 27 EDUC tasks, may be of a particular interest for specific stakeholders.

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Out of the total 71 EDUC outputs (**25 milestones and 46 deliverables**), 40 were identified by the Alliance as potentially interesting for stakeholders (27 deliverables and 13 milestones). To date, a total of 262 stakeholders, at the regional (104 stakeholders), national (100 stakeholders), and European (58 stakeholders) level have been identified. These stakeholders represent various government bodies, educational institutions, student organizations, research agencies, and other private and public relevant entities.

Noteworthy, for some outputs a relevant number of stakeholders have already been identified and they are related to the following topics:

Microcredentials, societal outreach, International Entrepreneurial Mindset, EDUC Young Researchers program.

To be underlined that this first mapping is not exhaustive, it will be updated on a yearly basis, taking into consideration final content of outputs as well as the possibility to incorporate interested parties who will directly approach the Alliance to receive information.
