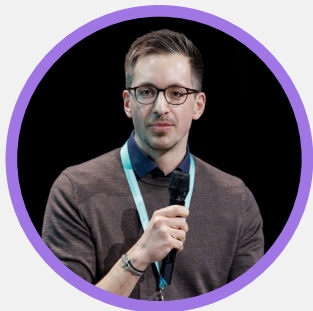


# 2nd EDUC Online Output Sharing Themed Event

### **Daniël Hübner**

Daniël is the Project Officer for EDUC on behalf of the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA). 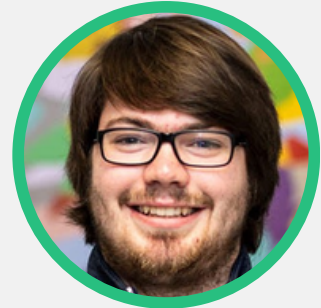
